

Hengrove Park



Fly-through Commentary

Welcome to Hengrove Park, the largest regeneration site in Bristol. The site will ultimately feature a range of new homes and employment sites as well as a high quality large park. Seen from the air this is Phase 1 of the proposed development. The scheme is comprised of four main projects, which can be seen here located on each corner of the first phase, surrounded by new roads and landscaping.

Visitors will arrive in the area from Whitchurch Lane and move through the site along a tree-lined boulevard. On the left is a potential site for the new headquarters of Computershare, which would be relocated from Bedminster Down and employ up to 1,200 people. On the right will be the Skills Academy. Run by City of Bristol College and planned to open during Winter 2009/2010, this iconic building will house a range of facilities to prepare around 1500 young people and adults to enter the workplace.

Public parking for the hospital and Healthplex will be located in the central area and will eventually be banked by residential blocks as shown here.

At the far end of the development the Healthplex and South Bristol Community Hospital back out onto the park. On the left is the Healthplex which will feature a number of health and fitness facilities including an eight-lane 50m swimming pool. On the right is the hospital which will improve access to healthcare for residents of south Bristol, to include a walk-in minor injuries unit, operating theatres for day surgery and 60 inpatient beds.

Both of these buildings face onto a public plaza. This will serve as an important public space but also as a gateway to the park beyond.

Designed for easy access on foot or by bicycle and well served by public transport links, Hengrove Park will provide south Bristol with a range of first class facilities and employment opportunities in one easy to reach location.
